New Snow Wardens

Last year we had a lot of snow and ice across the Parish with Devon County Council's winter service (roads which are salted) focusing on clearing major routes, leaving quieter roads untreated.

This year Fremington Parish Council has signed up to Devon County Council's Snow Warden scheme. The scheme enables the Parish Council to take an active role by helping the community in severe weather. The Parish Council has a stock of salt and specially trained volunteers who will distribute salt during severe weather. Our volunteers will be refilling grit bins and helping salt the public highways (including footpaths as best we can as it would be impossible for us to cover every single road.)

We have invited representatives from the Developers and also North Devon Council planners to give a short presentation and answer any questions and respond to the many local concerns ,

Fremington Quay Calendar Now Available

To celebrate the 10 Year Anniversary of the redevelopment of Fremington Quay, the Parish Council has produced the Fremington Quay Calendar 2012. The Calendar is on sale at £2.50 at various locations throughout the Parish, including The Council Offices and Fremington Quay Café and Heritage Centre.

The Parish Council is supporting local groups and organisations who sell the calendars by allowing them to keep £1.00 from the sale of each calendar they sell. It is hoped this will help local community groups and organisations boost their funds in what are difficult financial times.

Boost for Fremington Quay Heritage Centre

The Heritage Centre will enjoy sharing in a £70,000 grant to improve a number of sites on the Tarka Trail including the Gaia Trust's Home Farm Marsh Reserve. We are planning to upgrade the interpretation at the Quay and would like to involve the local community in this by tracking down pictures or documents about the site when it was a working port and by recording local stories on the port in operation. The stories and records can then inform the interpretation that will be installed towards the end of 2012. Anyone is welcome to get involved in this community project..

Outdoor Gym Equipment at Cedar Grove

The this month will see the installation of the new outdoor fitness equipment at Cedar Grove, Roundswell, which has been generously funded by County Councillor Rodney Cann.

It is hoped the new outdoor gym equipment will enable residents to get fit, or improve their fitness, for free and in the fresh air.
