

Fremington Parish Hall

Firstly, and as always, any suggestions for improvements to the facilities the hall can offer are welcome. We would also welcome anyone who would be interested in becoming a trustee or would like any information regarding this. To ensure the hall has enough people willing to volunteer their time to help with its running and upkeep.

The year 2023 to 2024 has seen an increase in the hall usage with space and time slots being filled most days. However, enquiries are always welcome along with those wishing to hire for singular events such as birthday parties and alike.

General maintenance and work continues to be conducted throughout the year.

Currently the hall is looking to invest in a new sound system/pa system and a projector and associated items to make better use of the space in terms of those who use sound systems and screens.

The committee is also looking to purchase a defibrillator to replace the one that has been moved to the parish council office as the hall had been the site of one for a long time. It is felt that this would be of use to users of the hall but also the community as a whole and will be suitably placed to ensure access to those who may have need of it.

The carpark potholes will be filled in due course pending quotes from contractors. The carpark itself will then be remarked and spaces made clear once more.

Lighter folding tables have been purchased to make better use of space. These will replace the older school style classroom tables, which have been in the hall for a number of years. So far this has seen a positive response to ease of use.
