# 1603/22 **County and District Councillors' Reports** - To receive reports from the County Councillor and District Councillors for information only.

Cllr Brailey reported that 2 x planning applications will be submitted this week for Anchor Wood Bank, the appeal to remove the listing on the Oliver Buildings was refused so they will remain listed. Car park charges have been increased to cover increasing costs.

Cllr Cann stated that the increase in car parking charges was also to encourage people to park outside of the town and in longer stay car parks.

Cllr Biederman reported that NDC would be increasing its precept by 1.99% and DCC by 3.99% (Band D equivalent).

## 1603/23 To discuss the Combined Authority Devolution Bid with Cllr Brailey

Cllr Brailey informed members that the bid had been submitted which would be a high level bid and the detail would be discussed at a later stage. However, they would be fighting to get the area the best deal and would be looking to see what benefits would be offered by Central Government. Cllr Brailey will keep the Parish Council up to date with progress. Cllr Brailey confirmed that this was not another tier of local government but 23 authorities working together to draw money into the area.

# To discuss the unfair enforcement by planning enforcement officers in the Parish (item requested by Cllr Mrs J Flynn)

Members were informed by Cllr Cann that a commercial premises in Bickington had been the subject of an enforcement case for its signage, it was felt that other commercial premises within the parish have similar signage which has not been enforced. It was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to highlight the need for uniformed enforcement throughout the parish to NDC.

### 1603/25 To consider a priority for planning enforcement within the Parish

It was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to clarify the policy on signage and banners.

# 1603/26 To consider supporting a Bus Shelter on Bickington Road & to receive update on the Bus Shelter for Chilpark

Members considered supporting a bus shelter on Bickington Road and it was **resolved**, with one abstention, to support a bus shelter in this location.

An update was not received for the proposed bus shelter at Chilpark.

To consider attendance at the Planning & Environment School 2016 It was resolved, with no votes to the contrary, to note the information.

To consider and respond to the North Devon and Torridge Local Plan 2011 – 2031 Consultation and the proposed policy relating to Wind Energy Development and a series of additional proposed main changes to the insertion of Policy ST19A: Starter Homes Exception Sites

Cllr Cann reported that the whole area had been identified as suitable for wind energy, however, CPRE had made representations to NDC that it did not believe this inclusion to be statutory, NDC decided to consult on the proposals whilst it seeks clarification so as not to delay the plan any further.

Cllr Brailey left the meeting at 8.40pm.

Members considered the report and it was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to support the future of the Records Office in principle.
