1403/47 Chairman's Announcements

It was announced that Devon County Council had confirmed the contract for 2014/2015 for the Highway Verges and the contract had been awarded. It was further announced that NDC had confirmed that the Parish Council would receive a reduced grant for the public toilets at Fremington quay the grant had been withdrawn following the introduction of a pay meter but now that is out of use the reduced grant will be received.

1403/50 Issues raised by residents at Fremington Quay

Residents raised concerns about the installation of the wooden galleon, parking/traffic problems; the boat parked in Devon County Council's passing place and the general abuse of the area by members of the public.

It was reported that the wooden galleon did not require planning permission, the Parish Council has gained funding and instructed a contractor to infill the potholes in the existing car park and funding was being obtained for the overspill car park with other options for parking being investigated. The residents were advised to ring 101 with any anti-social behaviour problems.
