It was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to renew on a three year long term agreement through the Parish Council's broker which it had worked closely with over the last six years to ensure comprehensive cover and accept the brokers recommendation to insure with Inspire, although this was not the cheapest cover the Committee was confident that all areas were covered and the additional Rradar Service that was provided as part of the cover would be beneficial to the Council.
