1 Welcome by the Chairman of Fremington Parish Council

The Party at the Manor had had a year off but would return in 2019, the group was pleased to be able to complete the stage and gate on the Village Green as part of the Enhancement Project. The Community Group had held several community clean up days and had undertaken bulb planting on the Village Green, they had also supported the creation of a new running group which now has around 200 members.
