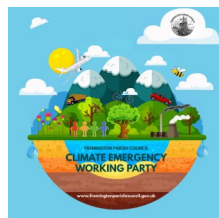
We also have a laptop computer in the reception area, which is available for anyone to use free of charge. The only charge is for any printing.

## Big Climate Fightback in Fremington



Fremington Parish Council, as part of the Big Climate Fightback supported the campaign on Tree Charter Day, Saturday 30th November by purchasing 105 trees funded by a Community Councillor grant from Devon County Councillor Frank Biederman. Fremington Parish Councillors supported by residents led a tree planting event on Saturday 30th November in three locations at Yelland, Fremington and Roundswell.
