# When and where will the even the taking place

Queen Elizabeth II Playing Fields Tews Lane, October Half Term Friday 23rd - November 1st

### What times will it be taking place

We plan to open from 2pm - 9pm everyday But of course noise will be controlled with a sound bar set

## What measures will be in place for COVID-19

1) the site being completely sealed with just one entrance to ensure limited numbers and a socially distanced queuing system into the site

The whole site will be completely fenced off, it will be unlike other times we have visited areas where the space is open and people can just walk into the site, this is why we have decided to go with the pay one price so we can control the amount of customers entering the site at one time.

2) each ride is cleaned after use to ensure hygiene is maintained

We are using zoono anti Bactria spray on all of the attractions this is the latest spray that is being used in airports. Zoos & other locations it is proven to kill Bactria on all rides up to 99.9% Also it lasts up to 30 days on any surface i.e. this will be sprayed on all of the handles bars

3) each ride inside also has limited numbers to ensure safety (2m gaps between riders etc) and suitable queues in place

The rides will all have a 2m q system in operation before entering the ride, then they will be seated 1m + to ensure their safety.

Rides that are seated and do not have a 1m+ distance will then be increased for example if a ride holds 16 people and there is not 1m+ gap we will space the ride out more so it will only hold 8 people

### How the site will be managed (parking etc)

We will have a parking attendant on site at all times

### The weight of all of the equipment

The rides Are between 2 Ton - 25 Ton

#### How rubbish will be dealt with

Rubbish will be taken back to our HQ Back in Exeter or Plymouth where our rubbish removal company

#### Reinstatement of the field after use

We board all of our rides on site at any time so we treat the surface as our own, in the event of ground damage we will pay to put this right

I do believe if granted this would be a fantastic for Barnstaple to still have a fun fair this year, we do normally attend Barnstaple in March also I did speak to north devon council and they did say they wouldn't have a problem with us using the site this year for a Fun fair but unfortunately building works have started on the site, we have been opened on council ground
