To THE COMMITTEE,

Further to my telephone conversation on the 2nd December I write regarding the ongoing youth problems of which you are already too aware.

Early in the summer a group of lads were banned by the police for anti-social behaviour. However, they have been replaced by three separate groups using the Shelter for drinking, Drugs. These groups appear to include underage girls.

We have provided bins for there bottles and trash but at least twice a week they smash bottle against the rear wall. We then have clear all this up to protect the children and dogs. When asked to behave some of the youths become aggressive.

You will probably ask why we don't involve the police again but you will appreciate that we don't want to become a target. We are now of us young and they know where we live!

It occurs to us that an obvious answer would be to remove the shelter! It has never been much used by the general public. A lot of the time the children and youths climb on top and it won't be long before

someone falls and injured.

We feel sure that without somewhere
to sit out of the rain we could
