I am pleased to be able to report that the Planning Application for Yelland Power Station has been refused. The Planning Committee for North Devon District Council met on 9th June to discuss this application again following a deferral at the previous meeting.

I attended this meeting and spoke on behalf of the Parish in support of our refusal for this application. There were numerous other speakers who spoke with passion about their objections including a statement from a 12 year old young man.

This application will now go to appeal and ultimately be decided by the Planning Inspectorate. Let's keep our fingers crossed for the future decision.

We are now edging closer to the end of restrictions on 21st June. Hopefully this will still go ahead. We await confirmation of this on 14th June so that we can all get back to some sort of normality.
