Frank,

Below is a plan to up-date the original white line and icon scheme at the Quay. Only change would be the suggestion of a double white line down the centre, rather than a single. I'd also consider an extra give way sign for those vehicles leaving the Quay. I've not included 'slow down and use your bell' legends but would include these in my funding bid and overall plan to a contractor.

I haven't included any option for Parking Restrictions along the Quay Platform area, but I draw your attention to the proposal I've added on the plan. This would create a two lane vehicular system and possibly leave no room to park? We could even barrier between the vehicular section and the pedestrian and cycle element. This would need someone with more knowledge of Highways to work up, and test the viability and worthiness of such a scheme, but it's an option? Feel free to raise it with the Parish and perhaps Highways.... Or just stick with the status quo.
