Finance and Personnel

Please find attached the draft budget for 2022-2023.

These are initial budgets for consideration.

#### Administration

The photocopier contract is due to end in May 2022, suggest leaving the budget as is but be prepared to meet additional cost from general reserves if necessary.

#### **Salaries**

No changes proposed.

The National Salary award for 2021 has still not yet been agreed.

Maternity cover will continue into the next financial year.

An Apprenticeship ends in June 2022.

The current salaries budget allows for the above.

#### Precept

There are not any significant increases proposed for the budget this year – subject to Committee discussions and therefore currently it is looking like a minimal rise of inflation.

### **Current Ear Marked Reserves:**

Election Reserve £5,009 – Elections are due to take place in May 2023
Cemetery Maintenance £3,000 – due to be spent, suggest putting further funds in from savings this year to cover earth removal of an regular basis.

General Reserve £9,487 Minimum Reserve £50.000

It has been agreed to allocate £2,500 from reserves towards completion of the Neighbourhood Plan.

It is recommended that further funds are placed into the election reserve and play area maintenance reserve. There are likely to be savings from the salaries budget again this year (around £30,000) but this is dependent on the national pay award and maternity cover. It is again suggested that the Finance and Personnel Committee consider the allocation of savings towards EMR's nearer the end of the financial year.

The Internal Auditor has indicated that there is a requirement for a fire proof cabinet to house legal records within the office – the cost of which is £2,300. Recommendation is that this is purchased using general reserves.

There is an aspiration to purchase tablets for Cllrs – purchasing via our IT provider would cost between £11,000 and £12,000 but we could look to purchase 15 x Samsung tablets (or similar) at a cost of around £2,000 which could be taken from general reserves.

#### **Riverside Park**

It is estimated that £95,000 will be brought forward for Riverside Park. There will be rental income for the facilities once leased – this figure will be updated accordingly in due course.

#### The Beechfield Centre

#### Dog Bins

Increase in emptying of £2 per week to cover additional cost.

#### **Allotments**

Muddlebridge - increase in rent to landowner for year 3.

Any remaining funds at the end of the year to be placed in an Ear Marked Reserve as agreed.

#### **Footpaths**

No changes proposed.

#### **Environmental/Climate Emergency**

Budget of £2,000 same as last year.
