### Letter from the Chairman

This year is the Queen's Jubilee and the Parish Council is hoping to join with others in marking the celebrations. If you have an event planned please do let us know.

The planning application for Yelland Power station site will go to appeal on 19th April 2022 and it is hoped that the Inspectorate in line with the District Council and of course Fremington Parish Council will refuse it.

It is disappointing that the extension to Mead Park has been passed and the traffic from this site will only add to the already congested road situation. However I understand that traffic lights will be put at Cedars Roundabout and at Sticklepath roundabout.

The Parish Council has reviewed all its energy supplies and is looking to install solar panels where it can. The Beechfield Centre cannot have solar panels because of the roof construction. It is hoped that technology will advance in the next few years so that solar can be considered for the roof. The cost of Solar has reduced in recent years so we are hopeful that in the future we can take this up on some of our other buildings.

Now the restrictions have been lifted it is hoped that we can all get back to normal. However we do need to be mindful that Covid 19 may be with us all the time so we all need to be responsible and take the necessary precautions.
