## Multi Use Games Area now open!

February marked the long-awaited opening of the Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) at the Queen Elizabeth II Playing Field. The installation was made possible by funds pro-



vided by Redrow Homes in the form of Section 106 Contributions. We had a small ceremony to open the MUGA with attendance from three of our ward councillors, Councillors Cann, Walker & Topps along with a representative from Redrow Homes. Two young men from within the ward opened the MUGA on behalf of the community and we were joined by members of the public who were keen to use the MUGA and were pleased it was now open. The MUGA was installed by TK Play and ground works provided by Dave Hocking Plant Hire.

Fremington Parish Council, and the Councillors hope that the MUGA will be enjoyed by all for many years to come and that it proves to be a great asset for the community.
