Minutes

Van Lease

Members were informed that the van lease was due to expiry in December 2023, however a proposal had been received to extend the lease for a further two years. Members considered the proposal, and it was resolved, with no votes to the contrary, to extend the lease for a



further two years, members hoped that during this time electric vans would improve, and a suitable size would be available, it would also provide more time to investigate the feasibility and security of a charging point at the Beechfield Centre for the van.

## Reserves

Members considered the Parish Council's minimum reserve level and felt that this would need to be reviewed as the Parish Council's monthly expenditure has increased. It was agreed for the Executive Officer to review the Parish Council's committed monthly expenditure and report back to the next meeting along with a recommendation of a minimum reserve level based on the committed expenditure of three months.

Members considered the rate of inflation, increase in costs and it was agreed to prepare draft budgets based on a £5 annual increase per B and D based on last year's tax base for consideration at the next meeting.
