

NOTICE OF CANDIDATES ELECTION ADDRESS SUBMISSION

Election of the Police and Crime Commissioner for the Devon and Cornwall Police Area

1. An Election is to be held for the Police and Crime Commissioner for the Devon and Cornwall Police Area on 2 May 2024.
2. Candidates for this election are entitled to make a campaign statement, known as an "election address".
3. Schedule 8 of the Police and Crime Commissioner Elections Order 2012 requires that a candidate's election address must be prepared by the candidate's election agent in the prescribed form (Form 29).
4. The Police Area Returning Officer hereby gives public notice that the deadline for submission of Election Addresses is **noon on Friday, 5 April 2024**.
5. Any election address must be submitted in electronic form unless the Police Area Returning Officer is satisfied that there is good reason for it being submitted in hard copy form.

Police and Crime Commissioner election for the Devon and Cornwall Police Area

1. An election is to be held for the Police and Crime Commissioner for the Devon and Cornwall Police Area.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Police Area Returning Officer on the 3rd Floor, Plymouth City Council, Ballard House, West Hoe Road, Plymouth, PL1 3BJ, between 10am and 4pm on any working day after publication of this notice.

3. Nomination papers can only be hand delivered to the Police Area Returning Officer on the 3rd Floor Plymouth City Council, Ballard House, West Hoe Road, Plymouth, PL1 3BJ, between 10am and 4pm on any working day after publication of this notice but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 5 April 2024. Candidates and agents are advised to book an appointment to submit their nomination papers by emailing paro@plymouth.gov.uk
4. The £5,000 candidate's deposit can be paid: (a) by legal tender, or (b) by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom and made payable to Plymouth City Council, or (c) by electronic transfer of funds. Funds must be cleared before the nomination is considered valid.
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 2 May 2024.
6. New applications to register to vote must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer (contact details below) by midnight on Tuesday 16 April 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
7. New applications for a postal vote or by postal proxy, and amendments or cancellations of postal or proxy arrangements, must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer (as shown below) by 5 pm on Wednesday, 17 April 2024.

8. New applications to vote by proxy must reach relevant Electoral Registration Officer (as shown below) by 5 pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2024.

9. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer (as shown below) by 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024.

10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy on the grounds of medical emergency or for work/service reasons must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer (as shown below) by 5 pm on Thursday, 2 May 2024. The medical emergency must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2024.
