The minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2024 were circulated. It was **resolved** to confirm the minutes.


**3 The following reports were received and noted:**

In 2014 the Parish Council agreed to accept the transfer of ownership of the land and asked if the Parish Council would approach the landowner to transfer the ownership to the Parish Council. The site has had public access since the estate was built in the 1980s and the original planning consent was quite clear on the usage as a children's play area.
