County and District Councillors' Reports

Cllr Biederman – Fremington Ward

Cllr Biederman informed members that a Cllr from South Hams has produced a book on the Road Warden Scheme which he will pass to the Clerk and perhaps the Community Group and the Environment and Community Group could investigate further.

Cllr Biederman explained that he had spent a lot of time dealing with the up coming gas works in Bickington which are due to start on Monday 15th June at 10am as there is one further GCSE exam and therefore, they have agreed to commence after rush hour. Wales and West have made provisions for carer workers and have also held a multi-agency meeting. It has been confirmed that the bus gate will not be open for the duration of the works and this has been a request from the Emergency Services as it might be their only route through in an emergency. The opening of the Bus Lane is still being considered. Cllr Biederman has asked DCC to investigate the option of an informal one-way-system around Old School Lane, however, they are reluctant for various reasons. Cllr Biederman, along with other NDC Cllrs, have organised a volunteer help group for residents that need assistance during the period of the road closure and gas works and have requested that people avoid travelling in peak hours if it is at all possible.
