- 1501/19      **Apologies for Absence**

- 1501/20      **Declarations of interests**  
There were no declarations.
- 1501/21      **To agree the agenda as published**  
It was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to agree the agenda as published.
- 1501/22      **Chairman's Announcements**

- 1501/23      **To approve and sign the minutes of meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2014 as a correct record**  
It was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to approve the minutes of the meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2014 as a correct record. Cllr Cann duly signed the minutes.
- 1501/24      **To consider cleaning arrangements for the pavilion**  
It was reported that there had been a misunderstanding with the arrangements for the cleaning of the pavilion. After discussion it was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, that the Parish Council will pay for 2 hours cleaning a week at a cost of £7.20 per hour until the end of the season; this will allow the football club to budget for, and take over the cost of cleaning the pavilion from next season.
- 1501/25      **To receive update on tree works**  
Members were informed that works had been carried out to the trees which were overgrowing the pathway and/or leaning on and causing damage to the perimeter fence. It was **resolved** to note the information.
- 1501/26      **To discuss linking the site to the public footpath**  
The Chairman explained that the aspiration was to create a gap in the hedge so that members of the public could access the footpath directly from the sports field; it was hoped that this would encourage dog walkers off of the pitches and onto the footpath. He explained that the landowner had been approached and was in agreement that the Parish Council could undertake the work. It was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to progress with an opening from the site onto the footpath and the funding through the TAP fund to meet the costs.
- 1501/27      **To receive report following a meeting with the adjoining landowner**  
The Chairman reported that the landowner was investigating opportunities for use of the land. It was **resolved** to note the information.
