- 1512/17      **Apologies for Absence**

- 1512/18      **Declarations of interests**  
There were no declarations.
- 1512/19      **To agree the agenda as published**  
It was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to agree the agenda as published.

It was announced that the litter bin in front of the skate ramp had suffered from  
vandalism (it had been set fire to) and had been removed from site. Cllr Cann agreed  
to replace the bin using the money from his District Community Councillor Fund.
- Members were informed that the Structural Engineer would be unable to provide  
further advice on the safety and suitability of the ground within the compound without  
the attenuation tanks/ponds below being exposed, there would also be another  
charge involved. As the Parish Council is unable to confirm that the area is safe and  
suitable for use as a storage area it was agreed to keep the area clear and the  
vegetation cut back.

Football Club take over maintenance of the pitches. It was further **resolved**, with no  
votes to the contrary, for the Clerk to negotiate out of the contract any unnecessary  
works.
