- 1409/02      **Declarations of interests**

- 1409/03      **To agree the agenda as published**

Projects were considered which included basketball facilities and surfacing for equipment it was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to delegate investigations and the decision to the Clerk and Chairman of the Committee, information would be circulated to Committee members before a decision is made.
- 1409/07      **To consider correspondence received relating to proposals to hold a dog show at Tews Lane**  
Members considered a request to hold a dog show at Tews Lane; it was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to agree to the event in principle with the price for the hire to be negotiated in due course.

Members were informed that funding had been obtained for the installation of an interpretation board, markers and kissing gate (which had already been agreed), it was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary, to agree to the installation of an interpretation board and markers and to delegate the positioning to the Clerk and Chairman of Committee.
