1609/42 Chairman's Announcements

The Chairman provided an update on the bridge works at Fremington Quay with a likely end date of October 2016. It was noted that the improvements to the Fisherman's car park had been completed and thanks were given to DCC.

1609/43 Public Participation

Members of the public raised concerns over Western Power turning off the electricity for a whole day on the 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2016, it was agreed to contact Western Power.

Concerns were raised over the Parish Council's representations on the Coastal Communities Team. It was noted that the Parish Clerk was on the Steering Group but an elected representative was not and the Chairman and Vice-Chairman had been invited to a consultation event.

The post in the passing bay had still not been repaired – Cllr Biederman reported that he had been chasing this item.

Members of the public raised concerns about the noise from the generators at Fremington Quay, it was agreed to raise with DCC.

It was noted that TAP money had been secured to create refuge places along the BOAT Road for pedestrians and the works would commence in the near future.

Members of the public asked about the structural integrity of the BOAT Road and it was agreed to raise with DCC.

It was **resolved**, with no votes to the contrary and one abstention, to approve the minutes of the meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016 as a correct record. Cllr Biederman duly signed the minutes.
