- Fremington Parish Council, Cllr Mrs Sue Kingdom, Chairman – the report was received at the meeting and is attached as Appendix A.
- Fremington & District Community Group, Mr Frank Biederman, Chairman – Mr Frank Biederman reported that it had been a successful year for the Community Group. The Group had held four community events throughout the year with Party at the Manner being the largest with 1,500 people in attendance and over £13,000 raised which is split between the groups and organisations involved in the event. The Community Group is pleased to have been able to support the Parish Council by providing funding towards repairs in the Babbages Play Area and it has also repaired benches throughout the village.
- Fremington Parish Hall Management Committee, Mr Frank Biederman, Chairman Mr Frank Biederman reported that he had agreed to take over as Chairman as a temporary measure and until a permanent Chairman is found. There are many committed volunteers running the hall and many repairs have been carried out over the last year. .
- Tomlin Hall Management Committee, Mr Brian Hockin, Chairman – it was reported that Mr Brian Hockin is no longer the Chairman of the Management Committee and therefore there was no report received.

4 To discuss matters raised by parishioners


The following issues were discussed by Parishioners:
